

FAQ's about your Winter CSA

Thank you for inquiring about the Goranson Farm Winter CSA program! The Winter Share is a 6 month, once-a-month pickup.

- The share usually consists of all the winter staples: Carrots, Sweet Potatoes, Onions, Parsnips, Potatoes, Winter Squash, Cabbages, Beets, and others. Leafy greens are included when available from the field or tunnels.
- The share is \$350 for six months. We encourage you to sign up using our sign up sheets (available at the farmstand or markets, or you can download and print it off online). Mail it in, drop it off at the farmstand, or give it to us at a farmer's market.OR you can also sign up online on our website (just go to CSA's and click "Buy Here"). We do prefer checks, however!
- IF you don't get signed up in time for our November pick up, we offer pro-rated shares (the cost of the prior month's share taken off of the share total). Call or email if you want info about our adjusted share total *after November*.
- The winter share pickup the **second Saturday** of every month, **November to April** (so Nov. 9th is the first pickup, followed by Dec. 14).
- Some folks split shares, but we encourage one member of the share to take the full share and then distribute to the other member.
- Anyone can pick up your share, as long as the person picking up knows the name the share is under.
- There are different pickup options. Please tell us when you sign up what option you are choosing!
 - For those who live close, we encourage you to **come to the farm in Dresden from 9-Noon**, and pick up your food right from the barn.
 - For those who live in Boothbay, or nearby, there is a **pickup starting at 9A.M., 680 Wiscasset Rd., Boothbay on Saturday**, and we ask you pickup as close to 9 as possible because the boxes are stored on an un-heated porch.
 - For those who live in the Portland area, we bring your share to the Portland Winter Farmer's Market, 631 Stevens Ave., 9 A.M. 1 P.M.
 - The following Tuesday after the Saturday pickup, we drop off boxes at the YMCA in Damariscotta at 9 A.M to Noon (picking up after noon is not an option).
 - For those who are **unable to pick up at a Saturday location**, we offer a Monday pickup at our **Farmstand in Dresden on Sunday and Monday**.
 - For those who cannot make any pick up options, we encourage you to ask a friend or family member to get it for you! We also can give your share to a local food bank.
- For all pick up locations, please bring bags to pack your food into!
- We can't offer to bring your boxes to the Bath or Brunswick winter markets, we are sorry but we have no space on the truck!
- If you don't want to commit to a monthly share, we attend three Farmer's Markets all winter (Portland, Brunswick, and Bath), and have our farmstand in Dresden open daily, 9-6.
